

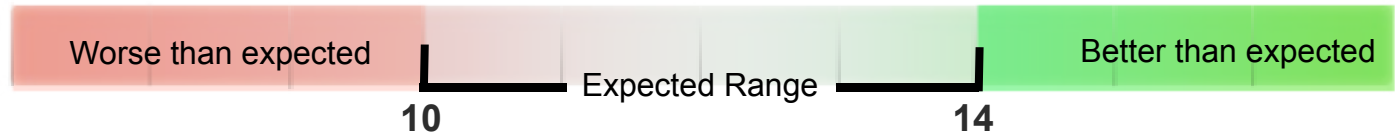

We asked them each what range of results they expected for the main parties and took the average of their responses. Check the results as they come in against consensus expectations.

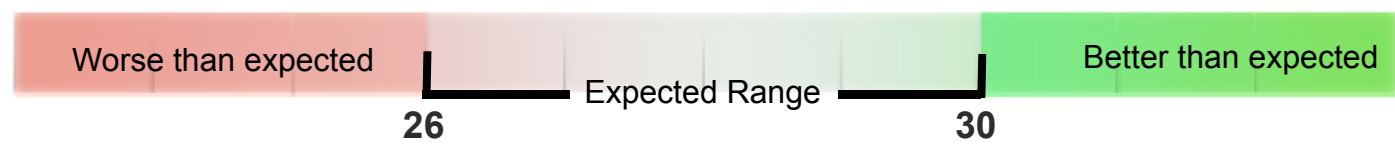
Labour Party

In 2004, 19 MEPs were elected, How many Labour MEP's do you expect to be elected in today's election



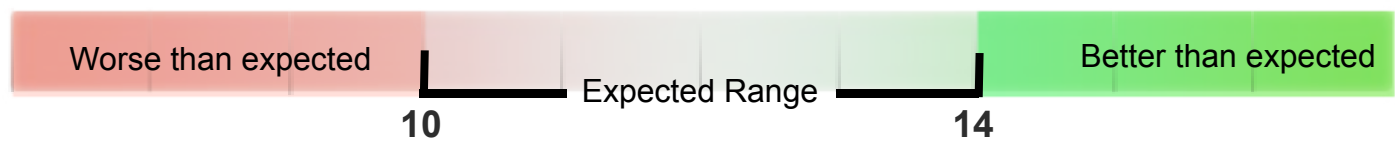
Conservatives

27 Conservative MEPs were elected in 2004. Roughly how many do you expect to be elected in today's election?



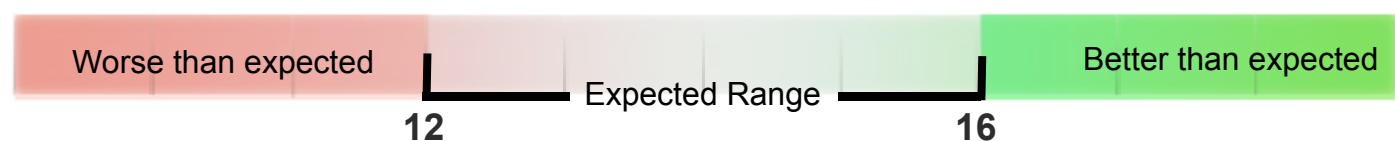
Liberal Democrats

12 Lib Dem MEPs were elected in 2004. Roughly how many do you expect to be elected in today's election?



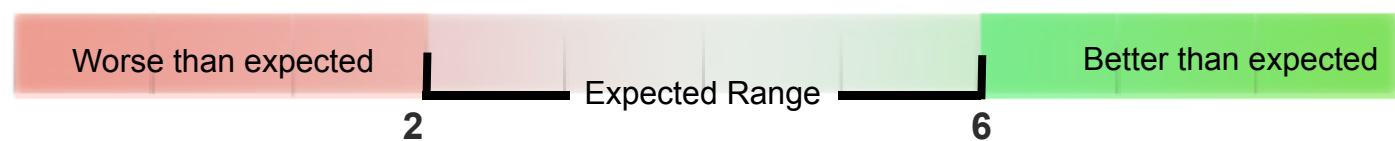
Ukip
